Individual Student Supplies by Grade

2023-2024 School Year

Parents,

The following is a list of supplies by grade. This is what each teacher would like each student in class to have. Please do not buy spiral bound notebooks for Lower and Middle School. They make a mess when the students tear out the pages. Your student will also need all of the books in the booklist. Please remember to pick up the general supplies listed at the end of this list. **ALL** students should bring a backpack each day to transport supplies and pack lunch in a lunch box or bag. **ALL** students **MUST** also bring a water bottle they can use throughout the day. **DO NOT** send any glass water bottles or glass containers in lunches.

Kindergarten:

- Ticonderoga triangular pencils— primary
- Elmer's glue
- Pencil sharpener
- an eraser separate from those on the pencils
- a solid color, two-pocket folder
- pencil case, plastic box type
- A complete change of clothes in a zip lock plastic bag with their name on it.
- refillable, plastic water bottle brought to class already filled each day,
- student Lunch and Snack.

First Grade:

- Sharpened Ticonderoga triangular pencils—primary or regular.
- 24-count box of colored pencils, sharpened
- One wide ruled primary journal notebook, with half the page blank for drawing pictures
- One pack of glue sticks
- a solid color, two-pocket folder
- 12 inch ruler (with centimeters)
- a pencil box
- Child safety scissors
- a reusable water bottle filled and ready to use for each day
- 3 erasers, separate from those on pencils

Second Grade:

- Sharpened Ticonderoga triangular pencils – regular size for the 1st semester.
- In January, sharpened Ticonderoga #2 pencils
- Red pens or pencils
- 24-count box of colored pencils, sharpened
- one eraser separate from those on the pencils - Magic Rub brand is the best
- primary wide ruled journal notebook. The top half of each page has a space for the child to draw a picture. (Mead, available at Walmart or Staples)

- Fiskars student scissors
- Glue sticks
- pencil case - fabric, not a hard box, large enough to hold all supplies above

Third Grade:

- 24 pre-sharpened pencils, any brand
- eraser separate from ones on pencils
- mess-less pencil sharpener (Fiskars brand or similar)
- 24 colored pencils (any brand)
- 1 drawing paper pad (any brand)
- plastic 2 pocket folder
- small pencil case
- 12 inch ruler
- 1 1/2 inch binder filled with one pack wide ruled paper - NO spiral notebooks
- one pack graph paper (for Math)
- 5 tabbed dividers
- small assignment notebook in which to write homework assignments
- non-breakable water bottle filled each day
- Parents may send their preferred brand/type of hand sanitizer with their students to be used during the day.

Fourth Grade:

- At least 2 sharpened pencils and your own non-motorized pencil sharpener EVERY DAY (mechanical pencils with .9mm leads are recommended, otherwise regular #2 pencils or 7mm mechanical pencils will do)
- A pencil erasers
- A black or blue pen, for handwriting (1st quarter)
- A binder, 1in or 1.5 in recommended (I will give each student 2 folders to put in the binder)
- Loose Leaf paper. Wide ruled
- Ruler with binder holes to keep in binder

Optional supplies:

- Colored pencils
- Children's scissors
- Pad of paper on which to list homework assignments r

Fifth Grade:

- Full, sharpened box of Ticonderoga #2 pencils - at least 2 pencils must be brought to school EACH day
- an eraser, separate from the ones on the pencils
- two blue or black pens
- Two red pens
- Pencil sharpener
- ruler
- A pencil case large enough to hold the above supplies
- 2-inch loose leaf ring binder with one pack of wide ruled paper—NO SPIRAL NOTEBOOKS
- extra wide ruled notebook paper for their binder (**students keep running out of paper**)
- 5 tabbed dividers

- two graph paper notebooks with 1/4 inch squares (4 x 4 quad ruled) composition type
- One wide ruled composition notebook

Sixth Grade:

- Mechanical pencils OR a full, sharpened box of #2 pencils (student must bring at least two pencils to school EACH day)
- Small pencil sharpener
- Eraser, separate from the ones on the pencils
- Large loose leaf ring binder with paper
- Extra lined notebook paper for binder, wide rule
- Extra folder or section in binder to keep returned homework
- Two graph paper notebooks with 1/4 inch squares (4 x 4 quad ruled) composition type
- Ruler, three hole punched so it can be kept in the binder
- Non-breakable water bottle

Seventh Grade:

- mechanical pencils OR a full, sharpened box of Ticonderoga #2 pencils
- an eraser, separate from the ones on the pencils
- two highlighters
- 2-inch loose leaf ring binder with paper—NO SPIRAL NOTEBOOKS
- extra lined notebook paper for their binder (**students keep running out of paper**)
- at least one folder that has a 3 hole punch to be stored in the binder. One for each subject would be wonderful if affordable, but not necessary.
- 2 packs of graph paper 1/4" ruled or graph paper composition books
- tabbed dividers for each subject for the loose leaf ring binder
- a pencil case with a zipper and 3 rings so that it can clip in the binder (this kind is big enough for a bunch of supplies)
- A ruler, protractor and drawing compass.
- a small notebook, journal and/or planner** with enough space to write what they need to do for homework and as a means for communication for the teacher to the parents and vice versa

Eighth Grade:

- mechanical pencils OR a full, sharpened box of Ticonderoga #2 pencils
- Pencil sharpener
- Blue or black gel or ballpoint pens with good ink flow
- A red pen
- Five subject notebook with tabs and preferably paper with perforated edges
- One durable folder
- an eraser, separate from the ones on the pencils
- One highlighter
- 2 graph paper notebooks 1/4" ruled
- A ruler, protractor and drawing compass
- A scientific calculator for math is optional
- Non breakable water bottle
- pencil bag to hold supplies

High School:

In general:

- a binder with pockets or a binder and separate two pocket folder. Students could combine all of their classes into one large binder but be sure to have a folder for each class.
- Pens, pencils, highlighter, and paper.
- Multi colored Dry Erase Markers and an eraser
- Parents may send their preferred brand/type of hand sanitizer with their students to be used during the day.

All Math Classes:

- Spiral bound notebooks (any type is fine but graph paper is preferred; students with regular notebooks will also need loose leaf graph paper; at least 2 or 3 notebooks will be used during the entire year),
- pencils with erasers,
- loose leaf paper and loose leaf graph paper, and
- a two pocket folder
- PHONES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED. Please provide your student with the requested calculator and make sure they have it on the first day of school.

Geometry:

- a **scientific calculator** (NOT an app on a phone),
- a drawing compass,
- protractor and
- a ruler

Algebra 2:

- a **scientific calculator** (NOT an app on a phone)

Pre-Calculus:

- a **graphing calculator**,
- drawing compass,
- protractor and
- ruler

Physical Science:

- Calculator (not a phone)
- Black ink pen
- Sharpened pencils
- Whiteboard markers

Chemistry:

- Scientific Calculator (very important!!)
- 3 ring binder for **Chemistry Only**
- 5 Tabs for Binder: Notes, Homework, Worksheets, Labs, Tests
- College ruled loose leaf notebook paper
- Black/White Composition notebook
- Black ink pens

- Sharpened pencils
- Whiteboard markers

Biology:

- College ruled notebook
- 1 inch 3 ring binder **Biology only**
- 5 Tabs for Binder: Notes, Homework, Worksheets, Labs, Tests
- Colored pencils
- Black ink pen
- sharpened pencils
- Whiteboard markers

Art:

- Students should bring in a 5x7 sketchbook,
- a putty eraser, and
- drawing pencils.

English 10, 11, & 12:

- If you have last year's grammar and literature handbook, please bring it.
- a wide ruled composition book with sewn pages (80-100 pages) to class for grammar & poetry vocabulary work.
- 10 page protectors for important handouts that will be kept in the student binder

English 9:

- a wide ruled composition book with sewn pages (80-100 pages) to class for grammar work.
- 10 page protectors for important handouts that will be kept in the student binder

American Literature:

- Loose leaf paper

Latin 1 and 2:

- Composition notebook
- Two folders
- One package of filler paper
- Binder
- Pencil
- Eraser
- Blue or black ink pen
- Red ink pen

US History:

- A spiral notebook that will be dedicated to US History only, in which to keep cumulative notes throughout the year.
