—Dress Code—

Education is a serious obligation, and a dress code contributes to an environment that supports each student's educational discipline. Alongside academic instruction, students learn how to present themselves professionally and modestly.

High School students are not required to wear uniforms but are expected to dress in business casual attire. Details of what that means at PPA is listed below. All clothing is expected to appear neat, clean and in good repair each school day.

Parents will be contacted when a student is out of uniform or dress code and may be asked to bring a change of clothing to school if a student is not properly dressed. **The director will be the final judge of what is not proper dress code.**

All Students Kindergarten through Grade 12

Hair	Hair must be neat, clean, and out of eyes.
	 Extreme hair color (i.e.: purple, green, etc.) and extreme hairstyles (i.e.: Mohawks) are not permitted.
	Hair accessories should not be excessive.
Jewelry/Make-Up	Excessive make-up or jewelry is not acceptable.
	Boys are not permitted to wear earrings or nail polish.
Footwear	 Dress shoes, tennis shoes, boots and dress sandals (with backs and straps) are permitted.
	Shoes are to be clean and in good condition.
	Laces must be tied, and any straps fastened.
	Beach wear, flip flops, clogs, or open toed shoes are not permitted.
Outerwear	While we prefer outerwear to be hung up when students enter the buildings, building temperatures can fluctuate, and we want students to feel comfortable while focusing on their schoolwork. Dress code requirements still apply under

outerwear.
 Any solid color sweater or fleece is permitted in cardigan or pullover styles. Blazers are also acceptable.
Hoodies are not permitted
 Dress code requirements still apply under sweaters or jackets.
Hats should not be worn inside.
